**Online Entries are preferred for Singles & Doubles - \$15 per tournament**

**Entry Fee at Tournament Desk - \$15 per player - Singles & Doubles**

**Players that withdraw after entries close, must pay entry fee.**



**Independent players MUST register on-line**

***Independent players are those that do not sign up through a pro/facility***

***IN CASE OF BAD WEATHER - DIVISIONS THAT GET STARTED WILL NOT BE REFUNDED. THIS INCLUDES PLAYERS THAT RECEIVE BYES, DEFAULTS IN THAT DIVISION***
